On November 29, 2012, Southern Ontario Military Muster (SOMM) was incorporated through affiliation with The Ontario Historical Society and registered as a not-for-profit corporation in the Province of Ontario. The SOMM became a Canadian registered charity on October 30, 2013.

Our growing membership includes civilians with no military experience, those currently serving and Veterans (WWII to the present day). We share a love of history and appreciate the sacrifices of those who served.

## OUR ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS:

Our primary charitable program is the annual Southern Ontario Military Muster show which has become one of the largest military shows in the area. Past shows have been held in Kingsville and Essex; our 7th show will be in Windsor.

Join us at the 2016 event on July 9th and 10th at the Windsor Sportsmen's Club, 2401 Dougall Avenue, Windsor, Ontario.

What makes this event so unique is that we invite **everyone** - Veterans, military personnel, cadets, civilians, vintage military vehicle owners, reenactors from all eras, historians, vendors, and not for profit Veteran and historical community groups together for two days of living history.

We honour Veterans and educate the public. Throughout the year, we attend and bring vintage military vehicles to Veteran ceremonies and community events.

Our future goal is to find a permanent location to establish a military museum where vehicles and donated artifacts could be displayed and enjoyed by the community all year long.

We share biographies in our SOMM Times newsletter and on our website. The SOMM Remembers - Windsor-Essex County is our newest project.

We encourage the public to explore history, especially their own family history, to uncover, understand and appreciate the sacrifices given for the freedom we have today.
