On August 9, 1974, nine Canadian forces peacekeepers were killed when their plane was shot down by a surface-to-air missile while en route from Beirut to Damascus.

2014 SOUTHERN ONTARIO MILITARY MUSTER SHOW UPDATE

For those of you who attended last year, there will be some changes. To avoid confusion, there will be one main admission as we will be using the new Twin Pad arena - Rink A for our vendors - larger and closer to the show.

Children's activities have been planned including a face painter, a scavenger hunt and an obstacle course.

There will be some new vendors and displayers as well as four new SOMM exhibits, some of which were inspired by our two scrapbook finds in the past year. These collections must be seen by the public and will be featured in future editions of the SOMM Times newsletter.

There will be an exhibit celebrating the 90th anniversary of the R.C.A.F. and the career of F/O Gordon Hobbs.

The scrapbook of George T. Lee, which was given to the SOMM, is a treasure which documents his time with the Essex Scottish between 1939-1944. An exhibit about the Essex Scottish has been created from these pages. Lee was a prisoner-of-war after Dieppe. His photos and correspondence have been added to our personal collection of photographs from other prisoner-of-war camps to create a unique exhibit.

The final exhibit focuses on civilian life during the war. Items include ration cards, recipes, patterns and newspaper ads from the Essex County area.

Unfortunately, the shipping of the Essex Memorial Spitfire replica plane has been delayed and it will not arrive in time for the show.

Just added - there will be three poster exhibits from Windsor's Community Museum. Windsorites on the Western Front; Windsorites supporting the war at home; and the multicultural influence on Windsor's war effort.

To celebrate the 100th anniversary of the Princess Patricia's Canadian Light Infantry, the SOMM has been given permission to play "the Ric-A-Dam-Doo" written by Bryan Adams and Jim Vallance at our opening ceremonies.

Admission: Adults - \$5.00, Children and Teens - 6-17 - \$2.00, Children - 5 and under - FREE, Veterans - FREE.
